

# Living Wall Sensors Code

\*\*\* Teachers can also preload this code on to the Arduinos so the students are only building the system and not messing with the code.

Here is the code for the CO2 Sensor with humidity and temperature as well. You will need to type/paste this into the Arduino IDE. Then click upload onto your Arduino. You will need to make certain that the LiquidCrystal I2C is loaded into the library.
